



Pool Supervision Vision at Peninsula Outdoors

Pool Safety Guidelines

When utilizing the pools at Peninsula Outdoors, groups must adhere to the Pool Rules and practice 'Active Supervision of Children' under their care. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the pool being locked and unavailable to the group.

Pool Rules

- Adult supervision of groups and/or individuals at all times (see 'Active Supervision' below)
- No individual to be in the pool area alone at any time
- No running in the pool area
- Pools are not available for use before 8:00 am or after 8:00 pm
- Maintain an acceptable noise level to avoid disturbing others
- Discourage activities like 'Bombs' and 'Horseys' into the pools as they cause water loss over the sides
- Diving into the shallow pool is prohibited
- Management is not liable for loss, damage, and/or injury during non-instructional use of the pools
- Peninsula Outdoors' led activity programs exclusively have access to the pool

If the rules are disregarded, the pool will be locked and unavailable to the group.

Active Supervision of Children

Active Supervision involves parents or guardians actively overseeing their children and includes four key elements:

1. Be Prepared: Be dressed and ready to take action, including unexpected pool entry.
2. Be Close: Parents or guardians of children under 5 should be in the water within arm's reach of their children.
3. All of Your Attention: Focus entirely on your child, engaging in conversation and play.
4. All of the Time: Never leave your child alone in the water, nor in the care of an older child.

- For 0-5 year olds and non-swimmers, a parent or guardian must be in the water at all times within arm's reach of the child, engaging with them actively.

- For 6-10 year olds, constant active supervision is necessary, and adults should be prepared to enter the water with this age group.

- Children under 10 years old cannot enter without active supervision by a person 18 years or older.
- For 11-14 year olds, it is recommended that a parent or guardian supervises by being physically present in or around the water.

Pool Safety Officer

Peninsula Outdoors can provide groups with a pool safety officer who will oversee guests at all times while using the pools. For booking, contact individual sites with the following options:

- Half Day (9 am – 1 pm or 1 pm to 5 pm) at \$220.00 including GST
- Full Day in two sessions (9 am to 12 pm & 1 pm to 5 pm) at \$440.00 including GST
